If you want to improve your English Language skills, this Entry Level 2 course will help you to further develop the skills you have gained at Entry Level 1. You will study Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing English. You will be advised at the interview stage if this level is appropriate for you to study. Your course tutor will help you to improve your use of the English Language. There will be practical and theory lessons throughout the course to help develop your skills.

Course Requirements

As no formal qualifications are required, the tutors at Stockport College will interview you and carry out an initial assessment to see what skills you already have and then place you on the most appropriate level.
