Course Requirements

Any adult can apply for GCSE English. Those who have a grade D or equivalent grade 3, or Level 2 Functional Skills in Literacy (English) achieved within the last 5 years will be interviewed for suitability but will not need to go initial assessment. For applicants that have older qualifications/no formal qualifications, your basic Literacy skills will be initially assessed through a written task at enrolment as well as the standard interview for suitability.

Please note: we are unable to offer you a resit if you already have a grade C or equivalent grade 4.
