



CONSTRUCTION BUILDING (BRICKWORK)

Level 2, Apprenticeship Framework

Construction is a multi-billion pound industry that deals with developing the underlying structure of anything from the maintenance and development of domestic properties to large commercial developments.

Almost two million people are employed in the UK Construction Industry with a diverse range of skills. Apprenticeships are well recognised and valued as an entry route into the industry. Apprentices with the determination and willingness to work hard will find plenty of scope to move up the career ladder.

Apprentice bricklayers will work on a construction site, to given specifications, setting out basic structures, building brick and block walling, laying domestic drainage, placing and finishing concrete and render surfaces.

Apprentices will receive training at college one day a week, learning practical skills in our workshops and developing underpinning knowledge. We also support all our apprentices to achieve maths and English where required. The rest of the week is spent in the workplace gaining invaluable experience on the job.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Aged 16+ years.
- Keen desire to work in fast paced industry.
- GCSE grades 3-9 in maths and English or equivalent.

APPRENTICESHIP REQUIREMENTS


NVQ Diploma Level 2 in Trowel Occupations and Diploma Level 2 Bricklaying, Functional Skills maths and English Level 1 as well as awareness of employment rights and responsibilities.

Functional Skills	Functional Skills will be required for English and maths at Level 1 or 2 if you have not already attained an equivalent qualification.
Assessment	Workplace assessments are carried out once every 4-6 weeks, observing practice in the workplace, gathering evidence of competency and working with the employer to ensure skills are developing on the job.
